“Reading Planet Rocket Phonics was launched at Holyhead Primary Academy in September 2021. Our school had previously used Letters and Sounds and this had mixed reviews however staff were very comfortable with it and a little reluctant to change. Some staff found the introduction of a new phonics scheme a bit nerve-wracking. I am pleased to say, things ran smoothly and have gone from strength to strength.

The detailed planning was so helpful at the beginning and made staff feel confident to deliver the programme and staff really enjoyed the flexibility of the planning too – as the weeks went on, staff started adapting the planning to suit their groups. The Facebook group was great; staff had the chance to talk to other professionals across the country who were using the programme too. Top tips and ideas were shared and used. Some of our staff also joined the webinars which also gave helpful hints to support teaching.

Children thoroughly enjoy their Rocket Phonics sessions including the interventions groups we ran for some of our Key Stage 2 children. They have loved working through the workbooks and reading from the Big Books was a big highlight in the lessons.

We had a recent OFSTED and as part of the inspection we had a ‘deep dive’ in Early Reading and Phonics. This was a success. **Inspectors were able to see how much the children loved the phonics lessons, how confident the staff were at delivering the sessions, the high-quality resources and the progress made by the pupils.** Our recent phonics screening data is something that we are also very proud of with 80% passing the test in Year 1, and those who did not quite manage to meet the threshold still made outstanding progress.

Parents and children have also loved the readings books that we send home. They have been fun, vibrant and interesting for the children. Even the most reluctant readers have been eager to read the stories and have become familiar with the popular characters in the stories.

I would highly recommend Rocket Phonics and am confident it will continue to go from strength to strength in the next academic year.”

Phonics are high-quality and engaging. They are the first choice for both teachers and the children. The stories are interesting and exciting and much more thought has gone into them compared to other book schemes that I have seen over the years. Children also love using their Pupil Practice Booklets. They enjoy the independent application that the books allow them to exercise. Teachers can use them as an assessment tool and the booklets make it very clear which children require stretch and challenge and those who need further support. Children have become more familiar with tricky words this year and have mastered reading and spelling them. **The leadership team have seen a marked improvement with children’s writing and Rocket Phonics has definitely been one of the contributing factors.**

Parents enjoy the fully decodable texts and have also commented on how keen their children are now to continue their reading at home. As a result, our children have made excellent progress this year and we have had some real success with children who previously would have been reluctant readers. that we empower our parents so that they feel prepared and confident when supporting their children at home.

Our children were fantastic and demonstrated the ability to confidently blend and segment both real and alien words. We are immensely proud of them and thankful that Rocket Phonics have now released their Year 2 programme so that this excellent progress can continue. 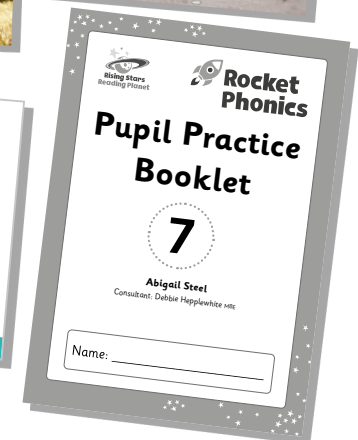
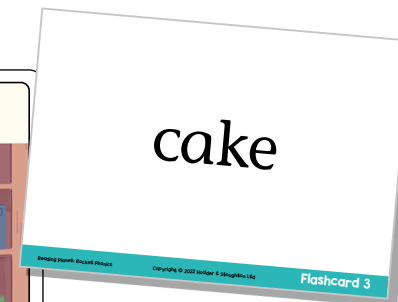
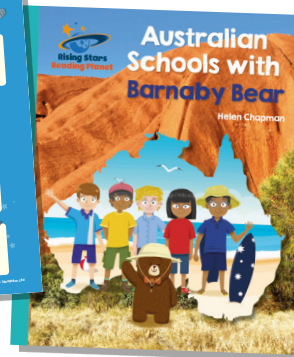
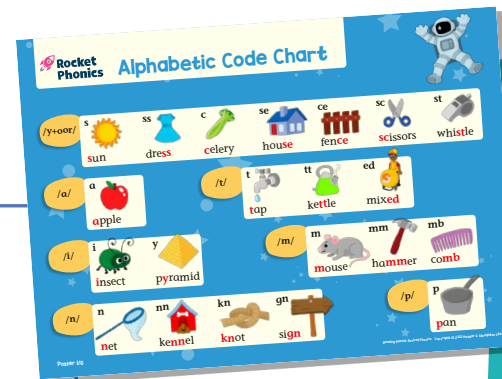
NEW Next Steps for Year 2 (P3)

Take children forward by consolidating phonics and developing key literacy skills in Year 2 (P3).

- ★ Build in National Curriculum requirements for Year 2 to ensure children meet and exceed age-related expectations
- ★ Use the established teaching and learning cycle (Review, Teach, Practise, Apply and Assess) to maintain consistency between year groups
- ★ Introduce and gradually develop cursive handwriting to support children in becoming confident writers
- ★ Equip children with essential literacy skills for the wider curriculum and the transition to Key Stage 2 (P4–P7) with a focus on phonics for spelling and writing
- ★ Use exciting fiction and non-fiction reading books to widen vocabulary and nurture a love of reading
